Data Backup Options

Several backup options are available to EPS users, including WUSTL Box and CrashPlan. As always, Hugh is available to help get you started and to answer questions.

WUSTL Box

Pros

- Support for Windows, Mac, and Linux
- Access files from any browser or mobile device
- Keep backup copy of data in cloud storage
- Stores multiple versions of files
- Easily share your files with other users
- Use the Box Drive app (Windows and Mac) to use Box storage similar to a network drive (https://it.wustl.edu/items/box-drive)

Cons

- Accessing large files and folders can be slow
- Box is not designed for transferring large amounts of data at one time

CrashPlan

- Support for Windows and Mac
- Comprehensive backup solution that protects your data in real time
- Capable of storing multiple versions of files
- Users can set data retention policies
- Access backup data and initiate file restores through the app or the web
- Advanced scanning tool that only backs up altered portions of files – therefore saving space and bandwidth

Cons

- Costs \$138 per year to protect 4 devices
- Limited to 5 TB of cloud storage
